Using the ICC web links provided for you on the WestMUN website, click into “Elements of Crimes”. You will only need to print up pages 5-13 for the case this year. Don’t worry about the other 80 pages, you only need pages 5-13 because they pertain to the recommended charges listed on the Case Summary.

By now you should have read the Case Summary for this year’s mock trial. Please note that Prosecution has the burden of proving facts that satisfy all elements of the crimes alleged.

PROSECUTION, DEFENSE, & DEFENDANTS: Study the Elements of Crimes for the recommended charges in this case. Please provide brief answers to the following questions:

1. Are the facts outlined in the Case Summary sufficient to prove these crimes? If not, what additional facts are necessary to satisfy the elements?
2. What research leads have you followed in pursuit of additional facts about the case?

JUDGES: Study the Elements of Crimes for the recommended charges in this case. REMEMBER: It is NOT your role to research facts of the case. You are limited to knowledge of those initial facts contained in the Case Summary. Please provide brief answers to these questions:

1. Answer question #1 above. Do NOT answer #2 above.
2. Read Chapter 4 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (pages 42-52). Considering the provisions under Rule 70, what facts in the Case Summary tend to undermine the credibility of the female witnesses in this case?
